● One-stop Contracting and Billing Center

Insurance companies, IT vendors, grantors and others prefer one point of contact. WNYICC is this point of contact for contracting for the Network. WNYICC bills the insurance companies and payers for the services your agency provides. We reconcile claims and denials and handle all the paperwork, process, and compliance that goes with billing.

● Centralized Data Portal

WNYICC maintains a network-wide electronic health information system where all programs and services are documented. We are committed to developing systems which do not add to your administrative burden.

● Training Academy

WNYICC provides training and education to our network members to ensure programs and services meeting fidelity, compliance, and standards while growing capacity.

● Quality Assurance

We offer a robust Quality Assurance Program for all programs and services. This gives you piece of mind to know that we are dedicated to improving programs in all areas: delivery, promotion, referrals, efficiency, capacity, and more.

● Technical Support/ Monitoring Trends/Advocacy

STEP 1) Interested organization's leadership meets with WNYICC leadership to review mission alignment and to learn about each other's agencies.



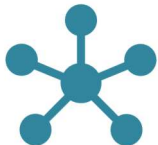
STEP 2) Interested organization completes WNYICC Network Application.



STEP 3) WNYICC Emerging Business Committee reviews applications and makes recommendations to WNYICC Board of Directors (BOD).



STEP 4) WNYICC BOD reviews applications and recommendations then votes whether to approve new Network Members.



STEP 5) New Network Members are on-boarded by WNYICC Team.

- New Network Members attend WNYICC Orientation
- Network Members select which Committee(s) to attend as a member.



STEP 6) Network Members decide which, if any, contracting opportunities to participate with WNYICC.
