Main hub development challenge for the network to address through this learning opportunity:

- Engaging our peers in the AAA system to participate in a CCH/Network model and mapping out how to start a formal plan for network creation.

Top two goals for network development related to establishing the Community Care Hub:

- Engage with other leaders of NLC and learn about the CCH network model and how to build this formally. By April of 2023, determine how Age Well, with AAA peers, can execute the model.
- Develop a 3-year strategic and financial plan for a network entity model designed for shared services, that results in improved efficiency, savings and integration within the AAA system. Complete plan by September 2023.
